Re: Continuation of Universal Access- 15 hours of funded kindergarten

Thank you for your letter regarding the National Partnership Agreement for Universal to Early Childhood Education beyond 2017.

I am committed to improving early childhood outcomes in my electorate of Sydenham. I agree that access to 15 hours per weel of quality kindergarten is vital to the wellbeing outcomes in our community. I would like to take the opportunity to thank Melton City Council's support the delivery of 15 hours per week of high quality kindergarten.

The Victorian Government will continue to engage with the Commonwealth through the Education Council and the Council of Australian Governments (COAG), to advocate for a sustainable and long term National Partnership.

On the 30 January 2017, the Minister for Families and Children, Jenny Mikakos MP launched a campaign urging the Turnbull Government to commit to 15 hours of kindergarten to provide security to families beyond 2017.
