COMMUNITY POWER I Street Art Project 2017

We are currently seeking applications from emerging and experienced visual and/ or street artists to create new works as part of the *COMMUNITY POWER* Street Art Project 2017.

The project will see several artists selected to paint new works on the power substations currently located within Woodlea, a fully integrated master planned community. It is expected more power substations will become available in future years.

If you would like to be considered as one of the artists for this year's program, you must:

complete and return this application form provide five examples of previous or similar work (maximum 1MB per image) include your current artist biography and CV.

A panel of Woodlea and Melton City Council representatives will make an initial selection of designs, with final application acceptance also subject to the approval of Powercor, as owner of the asset.

THEME

Each selected work must respond to the broad theme 'community', which can be interpreted in a number of ways. For example, artists may wish to explore community pride, diversity, service, inclusion, etc.

Submission deadline: submissions must be received by **5pm**, **Friday 28 April 2017**Notification of successful artists: **by Tuesday 9 May 2017**Installation date: **by Friday 30 June 2017**
