IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Registering your Animal for the First Time

Proof of sterilisation, microchip, concession card details and all documents relevant to receive a fee reduction must be provided at the time of registration. A cat being registered for the first time within our municipality must be sterilised. It is compulsory for all animals being registered for the first time to be microchipped.

Dangerous and Menacing Dogs

A dangerous or menacing dog is a dog which has been declared by Council, in accordance with Domestic Animal Act 1994.

Declared dangerous or menacing dogs, and dogs kept for the purpose of guarding non-residential premises, or have been trained to attack or bite when attacked, MUST be registered accordingly.

Transfer of Registration

Proof of current registration with another Victorian Council, and in the same owner name, must be provided to be eligible for the no fee transfer.

Concession Card Holders are entitled to a 50% reduction of full fee (Unless otherwise stated in the fee table)

To be eligible for concession fees you must be the card holder of a Pension Concession Card, War Widow Entitlements Card or a TPI Entitlements Card. Holders of a Health Care Card are not entitled to concession fees.

Kept for breeding by Domestic Animal Business

You must be registered with Council as a Domestic Animal Business if you are breeding more than 3 fertile female dogs or cats. A copy of your Domestic Animal Business certificate will need to be provided when registering your animals. For further clarification please refer to the Domestic Animals Act 1994.

Working Dogs

Working dog means a dog used principally for-

Droving, tending or working stock

To be eligible for the reduced fee proof or a statutory declaration will need to be provided.

State Government Levy

The State Government Levy of \$3.50 per dog registration and \$2.00 per cat registration is primarily used to fund responsible pet ownership educational programs and is included in the registration fee.

Membership and Approved Organisations

If an owner is a current member of one of the applicable organisations listed below, with which the animal is also registered, a reduced registration fee applies.

- Dogs Victoria formerly 'Victorian Canine Association Inc'
- Feline Control Council (Victoria) Inc.
- · Greyhound Racing Victoria.
- Cats Victoria Inc.
- Australian National Cats Inc.
- The Governing Council of the Cat Fancy Australia and Victoria Inc.

To be eligible for the reduced fee, the owner must provide proof of membership, as well as the applicable organisation's registration certificate for the animal being registered.

Approved Obedience Training Organisations

The following organisations have been approved by the Minister for Agriculture as *Approved Obedience Training Organisations*;

- Delta Society of Australia
- The Gentle Dog Trainers Association Inc
- Dogs Victoria formerly 'Victorian Canine Association Inc'
- Top Dog K9 Training Academy
- Four Paws K9 Training

To be eligible for the obedience trained reduced fee the animal must successfully complete an obedience training program with one of the above listed organisations or approved affiliates. A certificate of successful completion provided by a trainer approved by one of the above organisations must be provided.

Greyhounds

Greyhounds registered with GRV (Greyhound Racing Victoria) are exempt from registration fees and compulsory microchipping, with the exception of GAP (Greyhound Adoption Program) greyhounds.

Proof of GRV registration must be provided.

Standard fees apply if your Greyhound is not registered with GRV or is a GAP Greyhound.

Restricted Breed Dogs

The Domestic Animals Act 1994 requires specific controls for the keeping of restricted breed dogs. The Victorian Government legislation restricts the following breeds;

American Pit Bull Terrier, Pit Bull Terrier, Fila Brasileiro, Perro De Presa, Dogo Argentino and Japanese Tosa

Failure to declare the breed of your dog, if it is one of the restricted breeds above, may cause you to be liable to a fine under the Domestic Animals Act 1994, or prosecution in the Magistrates Court.

All dogs/cats aged 3 months or over MUST BE REGISTERED at all times.

Excess Animal Permit

Contact Council if you intend to have more than 2 dogs and/or 2 cats per property. A Local Laws permit may be required.

Control of Dogs

The owner of any dog must keep the dog under effective control by means of a chain, cord or leash held by the owner and attached to the dog while the dog is in a reserve or public place in accordance with the Domestic Animals Act 1994.

Domestic Animal Pound Information (Dogs and Cats)

- · Animals must be registered prior to being released.
- Fines will be issued for unregistered animals and animals at large.
- Pound release fees apply.

The Animal Pound is located at the rear of 90-92 High Street, Melton 3337. Opening times are Monday to Friday 9:30 to 11:00am and 3:00 to 4:30pm, Saturday and Sunday, 9:30 to 10:30am.

Closed public holidays.
