Introduction:

Melton City Council Youth Services team and Youth Advisory Council (YAC) are keen to recognise the positive contribution that young people make to our community. We will be presenting awards to young people to recognise their special achievements.

Melton City Council Youth Services is seeking nominations from members of the community.

Nominations are now open and close Sunday, 13th May 2018 5pm.

No late applications will be accepted.

Who is eligible for nomination?

Any young person between 12-25 years of age who lives, works or attends school in the City of Melton is eligible.

Who can nominate a young person for an award?

The nominator can be any person associated with the nominee through school, work, religious affiliation, sports, club and/or other.

Please note: Parents and relatives are **NOT** permitted to nominate their own family member.

Entry criteria:

- Nominees must be aged 12 to 25 years.
- Nominees must live, work or attend school in the City of Melton.
- Nominators must NOT be related to the young person they are nominating.
- Nominees can be entered in more than one category for separate contributions. A separate entry form must be completed for each category.
- Nominees must agree to the nomination and attend the Awards ceremony in April.

Nomination process:

All nominations must be made using the Melton City Council Nomination Form. The nomination form is available through Melton City Council - Youth Facilities located at 193 Barries Road, Melton and Taylors Hill Youth and

The judging process:

YAC aims to acknowledge ALL young people's achievements but in the case we are overwhelmed by applications there will be an independent assessment process. All award recipients will be contacted in writing.

Awards celebration event:

Winners will be announced at an awards celebration night, held on Friday 29 June 2018.

Award categories:

Being Heard

This category recognises a young person who has demonstrated leadership within their community, school, work or other hobbies/pursuits and is regarded by his/her peers as a positive role model. This young person will have demonstrated a respectful, helpful and positive attitude within the mentioned environments.

Being Inclusive

Being Inclusive category acknowledges and celebrates a young person who has been inclusive of their peers, whilst inspiring them to overcome difficulties or hardships.

Being All You Can Be

Being all you can be recognises a young person who has shown evidence of Active Achievement, Determination and Social Justice. A young person may have shown the characteristics of determination in the face of adversity and hardship to execute on their goals. The effort of a young person may have also been shown through social justice work for which the outcome was beneficial for the community. A young person's achievement, commitment and contribution in the field of sport and recreation may also be recognised.

Being Happy and Healthy

This category recognises a young person who is passionate about art and has shown the ability to inspire other in a positive and a creative way. Being Happy and Healthy celebrates young people who have raised awareness of issues affecting others through their art.

Being Connected

The Being Connected award recognises a young person who has worked to protect the environment and advocated for sustainability. It also celebrates those who embrace the rich dimensions of diversity contained within each individual within the community.
