BECOME A FOUNDING PARTNER

Sustainability Victoria is partnering with organisations that are showing leadership on climate change. This may be through what they are currently doing or are planning to do within their own organisation, or what they can do to influence others, including individuals and supply chains.

We are seeking these leaders and asking them to become founding partners of the TAKE2 pledge program and advocates for a commitment to taking action on climate change.

We are calling on Victorian based organisations across business, community and local government to sign up and be part of Victoria's leadership on climate change.

What we are asking of our founding partners:

- Sign up and take the universal pledge – *Working together, we pledge to play our part and take action on climate change for Victoria, our country and our planet.*
- Commit to take a range of specific action/s when the pledges are developed (later in 2016).
- Demonstrate support through logo recognition on the TAKE2 website – founding partners page.
- Commit to promoting support of the TAKE2 program to employees, customers, suppliers, and others.
- For industry associations, peak bodies, or community groups, commit to promoting the TAKE2 program through events and newsletters.

Why be a founding partner?

- Acknowledgement as a founding partner on the TAKE2 website.
- Promotion of commitments and achievements on the TAKE2 website and other media channels.
- Invitation to the inaugural Pledge Action Day along with other leaders, to be held later in 2016.
- Acknowledgement as a leader on Pledge Action Day.
- The opportunity to provide input during the consultation period and development of the specific pledge items.
- There is no financial cost associated with being a founding partner. Our founding partners have been targeted based on a demonstrated record of climate leadership.

INTRODUCTION

Victoria is again leading the nation on climate change by legislating ambitious targets and introducing a pledge system to bring government, business and the community together to achieve the collective goal.



The Victorian Government has set a target of net zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 and is calling on all Victorians to take action and help achieve this goal.

The *2015 Independent Review of the Climate Change Act 2010* recommended this action. In response, the government will enshrine targets in legislation. Government decision makers will also be required to consider climate change as part of policy development.

Working together, with practical action from communities, businesses and governments we can get there. Innovation by business will help develop industries for the future, and create demand for new jobs and skills to support Victoria's move to a low carbon economy.

The TAKE2 collective pledge initiative is a key part of the government's action on climate change.
