Infrastructure Planning Unit	No objection subject to conditions.
Traffic and Transport Unit	Based on the traffic report submitted, it was concluded that the peak parking demand of child care centres surveyed varied from 0.21 to 0.25 car per child, including staff parking. This is generally aligns with the requirements of the Planning Scheme rate of 0.22 space per child. Therefore, Council do not support a reduced rate less than 0.22 space per child noting that the higher rate is 0.25 per child.
	Based on the above rates, and the fact that site can only accommodate 25 on-site parking spaces, Council would only support the proposal subject to a maximum of 113 child onsite.
	It should also be noted that the parking demand is quiet high in the area due to the nearby schools and Council have had complaints from resident nearby in particular from Carina Drive abutting the subject site.
City Design Unit	Increase the setback of the building from the southern boundary. At least the staircase on the south-east corner of the site should be setback an additional 2m minimum.
Environmental Health Unit	No objection subject to conditions.
Landscape Architect	No objection subject to conditions.
Technical officer	 The existing stormwater pipe which runs between 514 high street and 512 high street of must be removed and the pit wall reinstated. The modified easement must still encompass the existing stormwater pit. Easement modifications must be placed on title.
