I am pleased to advise that, as part of this commitment, funding for the Municipal Emergency Resourcing Program (MERP) is ongoing and funding agreements are being renewed.

MERP provides funding to councils to support their strategic emergency management work. MERP enables councils to plan, prepare and deliver activities that will assist their communities in an emergency. It supports councils to effectively deliver on emergency management responsibilities established in legislation, state plans and policies including the Emergency Management Manual of Victoria and the Vulnerable People in Emergencies Program.

Funding Agreements with councils will be renewed under current arrangements for the period 1 July 2020 to 30 June 2024. Funding allocations to councils will be maintained at existing levels. Your council will receive \$120,000 (shared with Wyndham City Council) in each of the next four financial years.
