

City of Melton










- While City of Melton has a younger population age structure than Greater Melbourne, the 55+ years old age group is increasing rapidly
- > In 2011, there were 17,578 residents aged 55 years or older, an increase of more than 6,000 people since 2006
- By 2021, the 55+ years old will increase to 29,728 (59% increase since 2011)
- > By 2031, the 55+ years old will increase to 46,547 (147% increase since 2011)

- > Between 2006 and 2011, the 55+ year olds have increased in:
 - Melton Township by 2,861 (21%)
 - Melton East by 3,037 (11%)
- In 2011, the following suburbs had the largest concentration of 55+ year olds:
 - Melton West (2,766)
 - Caroline Springs (2,460)
 - Melton South (2,435)

The Aging Population



- > In 2014, there were 21,023 (16.6%) residents aged 55+ years or older, an increase of 3,445 older people since 2011
- In 2031, there will be 46,547 (19%) or an additional 26,649 of the 55+ years old
- > The 55-64 years old will double in numbers, from 11,433 in 2014 to 22,100 in 2031 (an increase of 10,667 people)
- > Older adults aged 85+ years will increase by almost three fold, from 788 in 2014 to 2,128 in 2031



Education, Income and Employment



- > Older people are less likely to have participated in formal education:
 - 36% of residents aged 55 years or older left school before completing year 11
 - 14% of residents are currently in the workforce
 - 77% of males and 58% of females are working
 - The median gross weekly income is \$377
 - 1,885 residents have volunteered in the past twelve months

Disability

- > In the City of Melton, 4,488 people or 4% of the population report needing help in their day-to-day lives due to disability (Greater Melbourne, 4.5%)
- > The incidence of disability increases with age.
 A total of 2,497 residents aged 55+ have a disability
- 47.1% of those persons that report needing help in their day-to-day lives due to disability are aged 60 years and older
- > There were 2,452 carers aged 55+ who provide unpaid care for a person with a disability, accounting for 28% of all carers
