Healthy headspace for young families

A free local mental health forum for young families will equip City of Melton parents with the tools and resources they need to support positive mental health at home.

Melton City Council will bring the Minds Matter forum to Fraser Rise on Thursday February 27.

This year, the program is aimed at families with young children and those starting their parenting journey.

City of Melton Mayor Cr Lara Carli said Minds Matter would be a valuable opportunity for parents to learn about promoting positive mental health, and the support and services available to them.

"We welcome 52 babies and 52 families to the City of Melton every week and we want to ensure that all local families have the resources they need for positive mental health," Cr Carli said.

"The early years of parenthood are full of big changes, joys and challenges.

"Being prepared with tools, strategies, and knowledge around mental health is so important and is why I raised this initiative with Council.

"Minds Matter is a wonderful chance for young families to gain insights, practical tips and information direct from mental health experts."

The forum will feature presentations by The Motherhood author Jamila Rizvi, expert insights on children's development and parents' wellbeing, an expo of local mental health support services and more. Parents are welcome to bring their babies into the forum and can book their children aged 2 - 8 into supervised activities.
