From story time to bubble making and music to trivia, Melton City Council has so much free fun in store for kids of all ages this Children's Week (25-31 October).

Children aged 0 to 12 and their families are invited to participate in a variety of online activities and workshops during the week, as part of a national program recognising the talents, skills, achievements and rights of young people.

City of Melton Mayor Cr Kathy Majdlik said the special online event would be a celebration of childhood.

Each activity is tailored to a specific age group and there is something for everyone.
