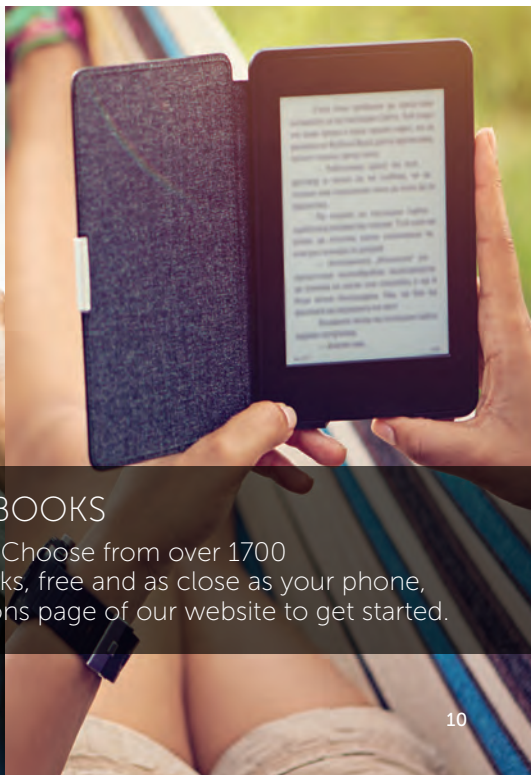

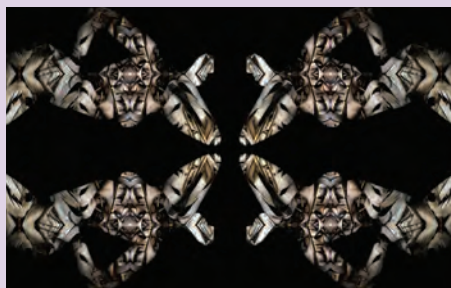

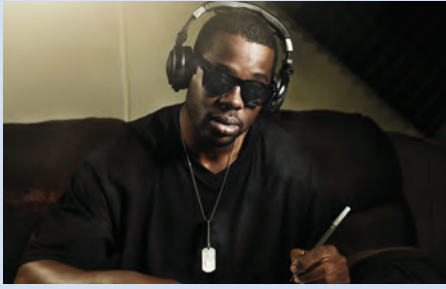
on their journey around Australia – and an all important map! Melton Library will feature a series of prints of the illustrations.

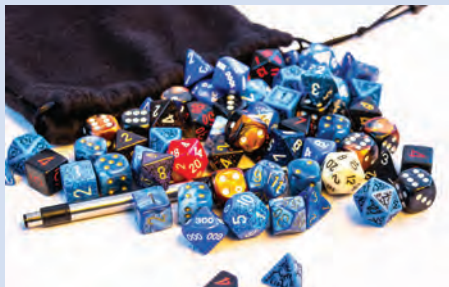

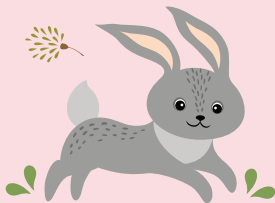
