- \* **3 Year old Registrations** completing this registration will also register your child into 4 year old Kindergarten in 2024. This does not guarantee your child a place into the above requested Kindergarten, however it means you will not have to re-apply for 4 year old Kindergarten in 2023. Normal offer processes and timelines will still apply. You will receive a 4 year old offer in July 2023 based on your above preferences which you can choose to accept or decline.
- \* Please note: If you cancel your 3 year old placement prior to commencing then your 4 year old application will also be cancelled. You will then need to re-apply the following year.

#### **PRIVACY STATEMENT**


