Babies who are breastfed are less likely to have:

- diarrhoea and vomiting
- chest infections
- ear infections
- fussiness about new foods
- constipation
- obesity, diabetes and other illnesses later in life
- eczema, asthma and food intolerances
- Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS)

- Lowering the risk of mum getting diabetes, some cancers, osteoporosis, and heart disease
- Naturally using up about 500 extra calories a day
- Saving money
