SPORTS INFRASTRUCTURE

SPORTS PAVILION

 - Combined sports pavilion with facilities for soccer and cricket including changing rooms, social rooms and toilets.
 - Entry forecourt to pavilion with seating, litter and recycling bins, drink fountain and bike rails.

ENTRY FORECOURT

 - Entry forecourt to pavilion with seating, litter and recycling bins, drink fountain and bike rails.

NATURAL TURF SOCCER AND CRICKET PITCH

 - 2 x Natural turf 105m x 68m soccer pitches with a centralised artificial turf cricket pitch.
 - Enclosed by a low chain mesh fence.
 - Ball catch fencing provided north and south of the field behind the goals.
 - New floodlights, coaches/ team boxes, referee shelter and scoreboard.

ARTIFICIAL TURF SOCCER AND CRICKET PITCH

 - 2 x Artificial turf 105m x 68m soccer pitches with a centralised artificial turf cricket pitch.
 - Enclosed by a low chain mesh fence.
 - Ball catch fencing provided north and south of the field behind the goals.
 - New floodlights, coaches/ team boxes, referee shelter and scoreboard.

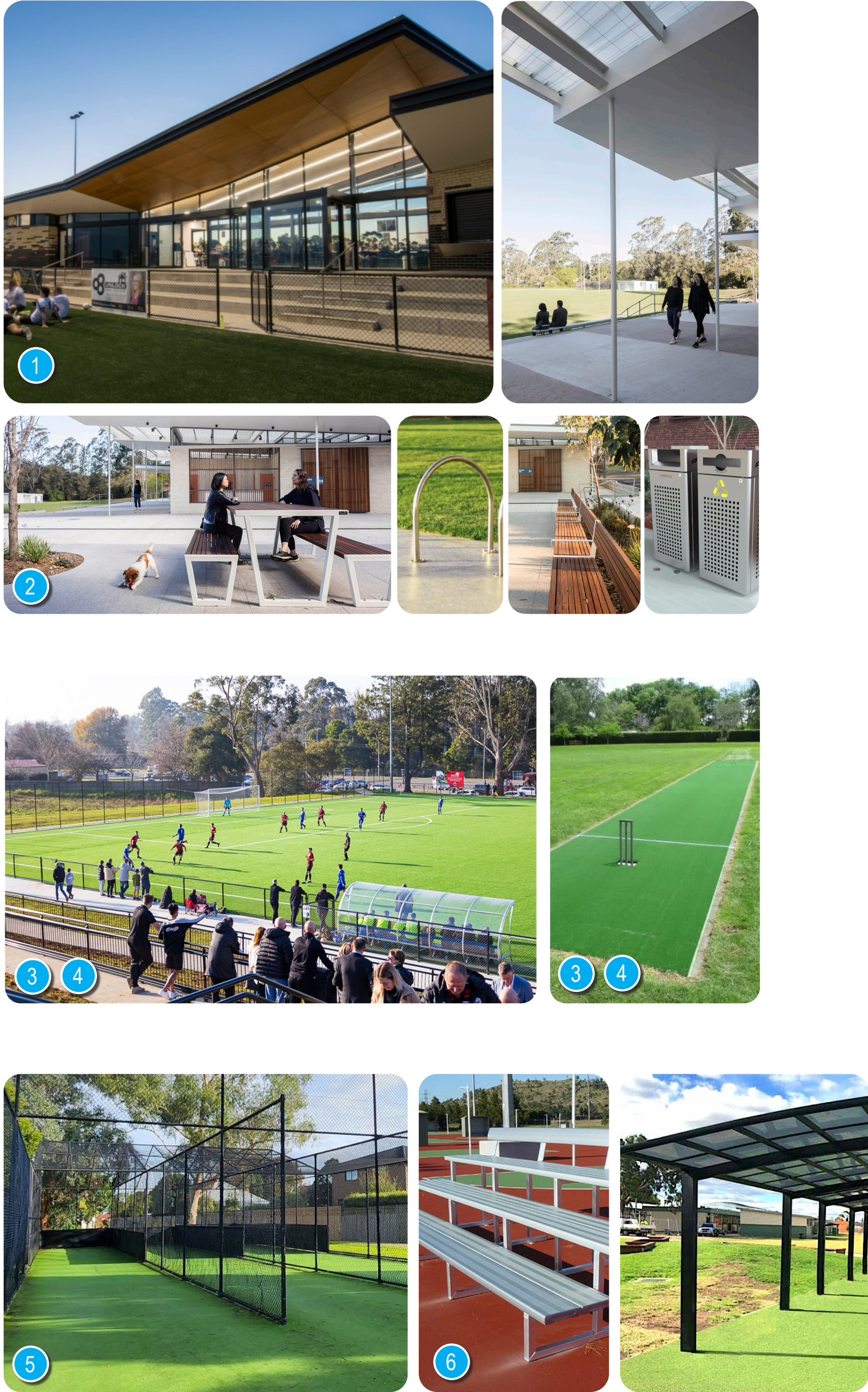
ENCLOSED CRICKET TRAINING NETS

 - 4 Lane artificial turf enclosed cricket training facility with small cricket store.

SPECTATOR AREA (INDICATIVE LOCATION)

 - Dedicated spectator area with seating and shelters.

CAR PARKING

 - 158 New regular car parking spaces.
 - 4 New accessible car parking spaces.
 - Drop off area.
 - Includes north – south pedestrian spine with raised crossings from Lightsview Boulevard.
 - Includes car park lighting, emergency/ maintenance vehicle access and vehicle exclusion bollards.
 - Incorporates Water Sensitive Urban Design, shade trees and understorey planting.

LIGHTSVIEW BOULEVARD MAIN ENTRY / EXIT

 - Main vehicle entry/ exit to the site.
 - Modify the median to allow right hand turns into and out of the site.

SECONDARY ENTRY / EXIT

Entry / Exit road from the proposed car park to the adjacent future children and community centre car park.

OTHER SITE FEATURES

PLAYGROUND AND MULTI-USE COURTS

 - Flexible community space which could include the following recreation activities: playspace, multipurpose hard court (which could accommodate basketball, netball, futsal, volleyball etc) or fitness equipment.
 - Includes new picnic facilities, barbecues, seating, shelters, litter and recycling bins, shade tree planting and low garden beds.
 - Public toilet will be located in close proximity to the recreation space.

FOOTPATHS

 - Footpath to provide internal access throughout the site.

PUBLIC OPEN SPACE

 - Flexible public open space with new shade tree planting and grassed open space.
- 13

DOG PARK (Potential Future)

 - Fenced Dog Park with dog and owner amenities such shelters, seating, natural dog agility elements, drink fountains with dog bowls and planting with shade trees.
