Good afternoon,

The Wurundjeri Woi-wurrung Cultural Heritage Aboriginal Corporation Cultural Heritage Unit Elders have reviewed the proposed amendment to planning scheme C243melt and have requested that I provide you with the following comments:

1. The proposed location of the riding school is in an area of high cultural heritage sensitivity and several registered Aboriginal places are located in very close proximity to the proposed location. As such, the Elders request that you avoid developing within this area, especially within 200m of Kororoit Creek and near registered places.
2. In addition, it appears that a registered Aboriginal place falls within the proposed location for the riding school.
3. If works do occur at this location, a Cultural Heritage Management Plan (CHMP) will be required under the Aboriginal Heritage Act (2006) because the construction of the riding school is a high impact activity and in a place of cultural heritage sensitivity (as defined in the Aboriginal Heritage Regulations 2018). As such, the requirement for a CHMP should be included as a condition of the planning scheme amendment.
