
# **Brookfield**Community Profile

## Location & Growth




- Situated in one of the fastest growing regions in Australia with a population of 10,785
- > By 2026, the population will grow to 13,561 (an increase of more than 30%)
- > By 2051, the population will grow to 21,708, an increase of almost of 11,000 residents (or more than a 100% increase)
- > The annual growth rate to 2051 is forecast at 2.8%

## **Population**




- > 192 babies born in 2019 (City of Melton, 2,711)
- > Young population, median age is 31 (City of Melton, 33)
- > 77% of the population is aged less than 49 years
- > The largest population age groups are:
  - 0-4 years old (1,084)
  - 5-9 years old (1,057)
  - 30-34 years old (940)

### Households



- More than 3,440 households
- > Average household size is 3.1
- > Household composition is:
  - 40% couples with children (City of Melton, 43%)
  - 21% couples without children (City of Melton, 20%)
  - 14% one parent families (City of Melton, 13%)
  - 17% Ione persons (City of Melton, 15%)
- > Average children per family is 2.1

# Diversity



- > Between 2011 and 2016, the number of overseas born residents increased from 1,386 to 2,437 (+1,051)
- > Top three countries of birth:
  - India
  - United Kingdom
  - New Zealand
- 26% of residents speak a language other than English (City of Melton 32%)
- > Change in religious affiliation between 2011 and 2016:
  - Christianity decreased from 63% to 60%
  - Non-Christian affiliation doubled, from 5% to 10%
  - No religious affiliation has increased from 21.5% to 26.5%
- In Brookfield, 84 people identify as being of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander background\*

- 26% of the population attend an educational institution (City of Melton, 26%)
- There are 1,084 babies and pre-schoolers, 1,442 primary schoolers and 891 secondary schoolers
- 45.5% of residents held an educational qualification (City of Melton, 46%)
- > 47% of residents have completed Year 12 (City of Melton, 51%)
- > University attendance is 3% (City of Melton, 3.5%)
- Bachelor or Higher Degree qualification is 13% (City of Melton, 16%)
- Vocational qualification is 23% (City of Melton, 21%)

## **Employment**



- 3,904 people are employed, of which 66% are working full time and 32% part time
- Most work in administrative occupations and technical, trade, clerical occupations
- > 12% work in professional occupations (City of Melton, 15%)
- > 76% travel to work by car (City of Melton, 75%)
- > 9% travel to work by train or bus (City of Melton, 10%)
- 13% are engaged in some form of voluntary work (City of Melton, 12.5%)

#### Income



- > 14% of households earn low income (City of Melton, 14%)
- > 16% of households earn high income (City of Melton, 19%)
- Median weekly household income is \$1,452 (City of Melton, \$1,542)
- Median monthly mortgage repayment is \$1,616 (City of Melton, \$1,704)
- > 12% of households are experiencing mortgage stress (City of Melton, 13%)
- 32% of households are experiencing rental stress (City of Melton, 31%)
- > SEIFA index is 976 (City of Melton, 994)#
- Average motor vehicles per dwelling is 2 (City of Melton, 2)
