

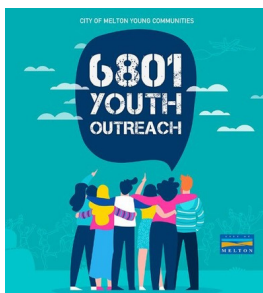

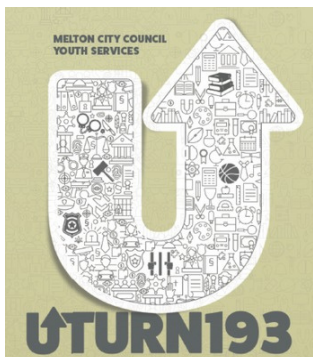
6801 Youth Outreach provides a safe, non-judgemental and confidential service to assist with information, support and referrals.

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## Other programs and opportunities

### Employability Skill Development Workshops\*

Young Communities provides a variety of free and low-cost opportunities for young people aged 12 to 25 to upskill and strengthen their employability.

#### Construction Induction - White Card (15 to 25 years)

Acquire National Accreditation and approval to work on construction sites. Participants will learn about Work Health and Safety processes and legislative regulations surrounding construction, hazards and risks with an interest in Victorian Construction in relation to the Australian Building Industry.

### Reconnect (12 to 18 years)

Reconnect (12-18 years)

The Reconnect Program works with young people aged 12-18 years who are homeless or at risk of homelessness, and their families. Reconnect aims to prevent youth homelessness supporting to improve a young person's engagement with family, education, training, employment, and their local community. The program provides one on one support, group work and practical support to the young person and the family, to help break the cycle of homelessness.

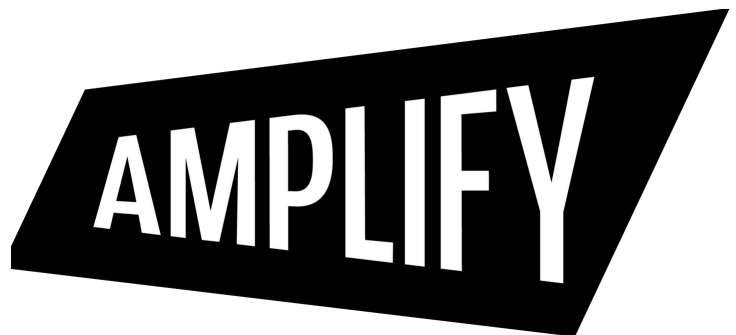
